Job Title

Forest School Leader's assistant

Purpose

Volunteer will answer to Nature Vibezz staff and they assist them in their role of running community project activities.

Tasks/ Responsibilities:

- Help with forest school / natural outdoor play / craft activities.
- Help with upkeep of tools / equipment.
- Help with supervision of participants / children.
- Help set up and tidy up after activity.
- Help Nature Vibezz staff record activity (attendance sheet, feed back forms, photos etc).

The role shall include some management responsibilities.

Requirements:

Willingness to be outdoor in all seasons and weathers.

Volunteer need to be enthusiastic, confident, good communicator, happy to work with the community especially children.

The volunteer shall need to be put through a DBS check as they shall be working with vulnerable adults and children.

Volunteer shall need to complete appropriate paperwork to be under Nature Vibezz insurance.

Benefits:

The volunteer will have the opportunity to take part in training provided by Nature Vibezz or free &/or project funded training provided by other organisations.

The volunteer will have the opportunity to take part in Nature Vibezz project events.

The volunteer will receive travel expenses (proof of expenses will be needed to claim money) while volunteering on Nature Vibezz projects when funding is available.
