

Evening activities

Highlights of the evening:

Night Nature Walk: Families were given a safety talk and gathered by Tivoli Park gates to head towards Streatham Common Woods, Forest School Leaders Douglas Saucedo and John Cannell led the group with the help of volunteers Sky Caesar and Sofia Vidal Martin. The walk entailed entering the woods with extreme care without headlights after adapting all senses to the dark for some minutes, learning orienteering and appreciating night wildlife...for the first time for many of the participants.

Snacks around the fire: A workshop about safety guidelines and policies about lighting fire in public and private spaces and the physics of fire was delivered by Forest School Leader Douglas Saucedo followed by roasting snacks on the fire and hot chocolate before bedtime.
